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CJSC Stroytransgaz Wins New Transneft Contract

CJSC Stroytransgaz will build a part of "Kuyumba-Tayshet" pipeline in the territory of 645,9 – 713,3 km. The project owner is "Vostoknefteprovod" Ltd, a Transneft subsidiary.

The project's objective is to connect Yurubcheno-Tokhomscoe and Kuyumbinskoe new fields of Krasnoyarsk region to East Siberia – Pacific Ocean oil pipeline.

Under the contract, Stroytransgaz will build a part of pipeline 60,9 km long. Most of this part of pipeline will be in Krasnoyarsk region. The construction is to be completed in Q4 2016.

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CJSC Stroytransgaz is one of Russia's leading construction companies that provides Engineering, Procurement, Construction and Maintenance services related to large-scale infrastructure projects in the global oil and gas industry. The company has been part of such projects as ESPO, BPS-2, the Bovanenkovo-Ukhta pipeline, and the Southern Corridor including the Kazachya Compressor Station.

"Vostoknefteprovod" Ltd is a Transneft subsidiary and was established for the operation, maintenance of industrial and environmental safety and stable operation of East Siberia – Pacific Ocean oil pipeline.

Pipeline "Kuyumba-Tayshet" runs through the territory of Krasnoyarsk and the Irkutsk regions. It will be 705 kilometers long, 515 km will run through Krasnoyarsk region, 190 km – through Irkutsk region. The future pipeline maximum capacity will be up to 15 million tons of oil per year.
