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CJSC Stroytransgaz will reconstruct 22 facilities of OJSC MOEK

CJSC "Stroytransgaz" has won a contract for reconstruction of heat networks and lead-in terminals at 22 sites of branches of the Moscow United Electricity Company (OJSC MOEK).

The contract has been received as an open invitation to tender where the application of CJSC "Stroytransgaz" has been considered the best. The customer of works is OJSC MOEK. The contract amount makes 737 mln rubles.

As a part of the contract concluded, the company will perform construction and mounting works on reconstruction of main heat networks and lead-in terminals to foamed polyurethane insulations and laying of a bypass pipe. It is planned that the works will be ended in December 2015.

The aim of the project is to enhance the reliability of electricity supply and energy security of the city of Moscow.

CJSC Stroytransgaz is one of the leading construction companies of Russia implementing high technology "turn-key" oil and gas projects; a construction partner of the Eastern Siberia – Pacific Ocean oil pipeline, Baltic Pipeline System 2 (BPS-2), the Bovanenkovo – Ukhta gas pipeline system, the Southern Corridor gas pipeline system including the compressor station Kazachya, and the Power of Siberia gas transportation system facilities.

OJSC "MOEK" is an infrastructure company providing central heating and hot water supply for the city of Moscow and a number of towns in the vicinity of Moscow. The activity of the company includes production, transport, distribution and sales of thermal energy, as well as generation of electric power. The company implements continuous power supply for 12 mln inhabitants of the city of Moscow, being the operator of the longest heat and power system in the world. The company has more than 16 thou. km of heat network in service.

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
